Poland plans social-media ban for children under 15

Poland's government plans legislation banning social media for children under 15, making platforms responsible for verifying users' ages. Education Minister Barbara Nowacka told Bloomberg the ruling Civic Coalition would present a draft outline on Friday, with fines for services accessible to younger users. The law could take effect in early 2027, citing youth mental-health and learning concerns. Other European countries are exploring similar limits, and Britain is weighing restrictions after Australia's December ban, potentially clashing with major U.S. tech firms.



Russia says local truce established to enable repairs at Zaporizhzhia nuclear plant

Russia says a local ceasefire took effect around Ukraine's Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plant to allow repairs to an external power line supplying electricity to the site. The plant, Europe's largest, has been under Russian control since 2022 and is not generating power, but needs outside electricity to keep nuclear material cool. Russia says one line is still working and the other may take at least a week to fix; radiation levels are normal.



South Korea set to finally get a fully functioning Google Maps

South Korea approved Google's request to export high-precision (1:5000 scale) map data to overseas servers, reversing a two-decade policy that previously blocked similar bids in 2007 and 2016 over security concerns. The approval comes with strict conditions, including blurring sensitive military sites, limiting coordinates, processing data on local servers, and exporting only pre-approved navigation data. The move could weaken local map leaders Naver and Kakao, while addressing U.S. complaints about discrimination.
