**Oil prices jump
and shares fall
as conflict
escalates**

Global oil prices surged as Iran continued strikes in the Middle East in retaliation for US and Israeli attacks. Brent crude rose 10% to over \$82 a barrel after attacks on at least three ships near the Strait of Hormuz, while natural gas jumped up to 25%. Iran warned vessels to avoid the crucial waterway, which handles about 20% of global oil and gas. European markets fell, with France's CAC-40 down 1.6% and Germany's DAX 1.7%, while the FTSE 100 opened nearly 1% lower. Gold rose 2.3% to \$5,395.99 an ounce. Shipping disruptions threaten higher energy prices, though analysts note infrastructure remains largely untouched.

**Iranian drone
hit RAF base,
Cyprus
president says**

An Iranian drone crashed into a British Royal Air Force base in Cyprus on Sunday, Cypriot President Nikos Christodoulides said. No casualties were reported, and the base sustained minimal damage. The UK Ministry of Defence stated that family members would be relocated as a precaution. The incident occurred at RAF Akrotiri around midnight local time. The Sovereign Base Areas Administration said the temporary dispersal only affects the military base, not nearby residents. European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen confirmed full EU support for the UK and its member states against any potential threat.

**Several U.S.
military aircraft
crash in Kuwait as
Iranian strikes
continue**

Several U.S. military aircraft crashed in Kuwait early Monday, but all crew members survived and are in stable condition, the Kuwaiti Ministry of Defence said, amid escalating Middle East tensions. Smoke was also seen near the U.S. Embassy in Kuwait City, with fire trucks and ambulances responding. Kuwait intercepted hostile drones, marking the third consecutive day of Iranian retaliatory strikes over U.S. and Israeli attacks on Iran. Crews from the crashed aircraft were evacuated to hospitals in coordination with U.S. forces. Iranian state media cited the Revolutionary Guard claiming responsibility for hitting a U.S. plane. The exact number of aircraft was unspecified.
