### France to boost nuclear arsenal and extend deterrence to European allies

France will expand its nuclear arsenal and extend its deterrence to other European countries, President Emmanuel Macron announced in Brittany. He said the strategic environment is increasingly unstable, calling the next 50 years “an era of nuclear weapons.” France will increase its roughly 300 nuclear warheads and launch a new nuclear-armed submarine, The Invincible, in 2036. Eight European nations—the UK, Germany, Poland, Netherlands, Belgium, Greece, Sweden, and Denmark—will join an “advanced deterrence” strategy, participating in exercises and hosting bases. The plan includes space-based warning systems, air defences, and long-range missiles to complicate adversaries’ calculations.



### China removes three retired generals from national advisory body

China has removed three retired military generals—Han Weiguo, Gao Jin, and Liu Lei—from the top political advisory body, the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), just days before its annual Two Sessions, state media reported Monday. No explanation was given, but the move follows a recent wave of military purges. Han, 70, led the PLA ground forces until 2021; Liu, 70, was the army’s political commissar; Gao, 67, headed the Strategic Support Force and later the Central Military Commission’s Logistic Support Department. Other CPPCC members, including defence official Zhang Kejian, were also dismissed amid anti-corruption investigations.



### Melania Trump chairs UN Security Council meeting on children in conflict amid Iran strikes

First Lady Melania Trump presided over a UN Security Council meeting on children and education in conflict in New York on Monday, marking the first time a world leader’s spouse has chaired such a session. Speaking on behalf of the US, she emphasized education’s role in promoting tolerance and world peace, offered condolences to families of fallen US service members, and extended wishes for recovery to the injured. UN officials highlighted the impact of regional conflicts on children, noting school closures in Israel, UAE, Qatar, Bahrain, and Oman, and reports of a deadly strike on an Iranian elementary school.
