Who is Mojtaba Khamenei, Iran's new supreme leader?

Mojtaba Khamenei, 56, son of Iran's Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, has reportedly been chosen as his successor after US-Israeli strikes killed his father. Long viewed as influential behind the scenes, he kept a low public profile, held no government office, and rarely appeared publicly. Educated in Tehran and later in Qom, he remains a mid-ranking cleric, though allies have increasingly called him "Ayatollah." He has faced accusations of interfering in the 2005 and 2009 presidential elections. His selection may be controversial because Iran rejects hereditary rule, and many doubt whether he can preserve the Islamic Republic amid deep public discontent today.

India offered sanctuary to Iranian ship three days before US sank it

According to the passage, India allowed three Iranian warships to dock after Iran requested permission on 28 February, shortly after the US-Israel war on Iran began. Foreign Minister S Jaishankar said approval was granted on 1 March. One vessel, Iris Lavan, docked in Kochi on 4 March, while Sri Lanka sheltered Iris Bushehr after engine trouble. Iris Dena, which had earlier joined an Indian-hosted naval exercise, was torpedoed by a US submarine on 4 March near Sri Lanka, sinking with 130 sailors aboard and killing at least 87. The attack widened the conflict beyond the Middle East, raising regional security concerns.

Indonesia to ban social media and other online platforms for under 16s

Indonesia will ban children under 16 from using high-risk social media and online platforms from 28 March, targeting services including YouTube, TikTok, Facebook, Instagram, X, Threads, Bigo Live and Roblox. Communications Minister Meutya Hafid said the move aims to protect young people from pornography, cyberbullying, scams and addiction. Some parents welcomed the decision, while others argued a softer approach would be better. Rights groups warned that child safety should also involve platform design, privacy protections and freedom of expression. Indonesia joins countries such as Australia, Spain and the UK in considering stricter age-based digital access rules for children and teens.
