Tehran 'lashing out' at Gulf countries is not a surprise, Iranians tell BBC

Iranian officials told the BBC that Tehran's targeting of Gulf countries is not surprising, arguing that the regime is resorting to pressure by threatening the global economy as the war expands. While Iran insists it is not targeting civilian areas, Gulf states continue to deal with attacks they say they have been unfairly drawn into. In the UAE, footage of debris hitting the airport, a residential building, and a hotel has circulated widely, despite ongoing interception efforts. Concern is also growing over the future of relations between Iran and the Gulf, particularly Oman and the UAE, if the regime remains in place, amid fears of broader consequences for Iranians themselves.

Formula 1 calls off April races in Bahrain and Saudi Arabia due to Iran war

Formula 1 and the FIA announced that the Bahrain and Saudi Arabian Grands Prix will not take place in April due to security concerns linked to the war with Iran. The two races had been scheduled for April 12 in Bahrain and April 19 in Jeddah, with confirmation that no replacement events will be held during the same month. F1 and FIA officials said the decision was difficult but necessary, stressing that safety remains the top priority. It has not yet been decided whether the two races will be rescheduled later, despite their importance to the championship calendar.

Trump warns of more strikes on Iran's Kharg Island, pressures allies to secure oil chokepoint

President Donald Trump threatened additional strikes on Iran's key oil export hub, Kharg Island, and said he was not ready to accept Tehran's terms for ending the war. His remarks signaled a major escalation as the U.S.-Israeli conflict with Iran entered its third week, disrupting the Strait of Hormuz and rattling global energy markets. Iran's Revolutionary Guards said they launched more missiles at Israel and U.S. bases, while diplomatic efforts stalled. With oil prices rising and shipping severely affected, fears are growing that the war and energy crisis could continue without a clear resolution.
