**Israel's Katz says Iran's security chief killed, Tehran strikes Gulf neighbours**

Israel's Defence Minister said Ali Larjani, Iran's security chief, and Basij commander Gholamreza Soleimani were killed in overnight airstrikes, though Tehran has not confirmed the claims. At the same time, Iran continued missile attacks on Israel and Gulf neighbours, targeting oil, transport, and U.S.-linked sites and pushing energy prices higher. The war has entered its third week, with more than 2,000 people reported killed and no sign of de-escalation. Israel says it will keep targeting senior Iranian officials, while the closure of the Strait of Hormuz continues to threaten global energy markets.

**Pakistan air strike kills at least 100 at Kabul drug rehab centre**

At least 100 people were killed in an air strike on a drug rehabilitation centre in Kabul that the Taliban government blamed on Pakistan, though Taliban officials claimed the toll could be far higher. Pakistan denied targeting a health facility, saying it struck militant infrastructure with precision. Afghan officials said around 2,000 people were being treated at the centre and that no military sites were nearby. The strike comes amid renewed cross-border fighting, with tensions escalating sharply despite a fragile ceasefire, as China and others call for restraint and an immediate de-escalation.

**Trump muses over 'taking Cuba' as island's power grid collapses after weeks of US oil blockade**

President Donald Trump said he might have the "honor of taking Cuba," without clarifying what form that could take, as Cuba's national power grid suffered another major collapse on March 16. The blackout came amid a worsening fuel and economic crisis tied to a U.S. oil squeeze that has sharply reduced shipments from Venezuela and others. Cuban officials blamed the U.S. for deepening the hardship, while unrest has grown in recent days as outages, shortages, and transport disruptions spread across the island.
