### Trump wants a deal with Iran but success of talks unlikely, Israeli officials say

Donald Trump is pushing for a deal with Iran to end Middle East hostilities, according to three senior Israeli officials. They believe success is unlikely because Iran is not expected to accept U.S. demands, including limits on its nuclear and ballistic missile programs. Trump said recent contacts were productive, but Iran denied any negotiations took place. Benjamin Netanyahu said Trump sees a possible deal that would preserve Israel's vital interests after recent military gains in region.



### Japan to drop 'most important' tag for China ties

Japan plans to stop calling China ties "one of its most important" in its annual Diplomatic Bluebook, reflecting worsening relations with Beijing. The new wording describes China instead as an important neighbour and the relationship as strategic and mutually beneficial. Reuters says the change follows disputes over rare earth export controls, radar lock-ons, pressure around Taiwan, seafood restrictions, and other retaliatory steps. It also comes as Tokyo and Washington move to reduce dependence on Chinese critical mineral supply chains.



### Oil rises as supply disruption persists and Iran denies US talks

Oil prices rose Tuesday after Monday's sharp drop, as traders focused on continued supply disruption in the Gulf and Iran's denial that it held talks with Washington. Reuters says Brent climbed to about \$101.77 and WTI to \$90.34. Around one-fifth of global oil and LNG flows through the Strait of Hormuz remain disrupted, which the IEA called the biggest oil supply shock ever. Macquarie said Brent could hit \$150 if the strait stays effectively closed through April.
