Potential Houthi threat to Red Sea shipping could further damage global economy

The Houthis have resumed attacks by firing missiles toward Israel, but their greater threat lies in the Red Sea. If they again target shipping through the Bab al-Mandab Strait, alongside Iran's pressure on the Strait of Hormuz, two critical trade and energy routes could be severely disrupted, further harming the global economy. The group could also threaten Gulf energy and military infrastructure. Any sustained escalation would widen the war, risk renewed conflict inside Yemen, and raise the economic and security costs across the region and beyond.

'No Kings' protests take place nationwide

"No Kings" protests took place across the United States on Saturday, with demonstrators rallying against President Donald Trump's policies, rising living costs, and the war with Iran. Large marches were held in Los Angeles and New York, while Minnesota hosted the day's main event with Bruce Springsteen and several high-profile speakers. Organizers described it as the third major round of 'No Kings' protests, following mass demonstrations last year. The rallies come amid economic pressure, high gas prices, and growing public frustration over immigration policies and foreign policy.

Bank of America agrees to pay \$72.5 million to settle Epstein accusers' lawsuit

Bank of America agreed to pay \$72.5 million to settle a civil lawsuit brought by women who accused the bank of helping enable Jeffrey Epstein's abuse by ignoring suspicious financial activity. The bank denied facilitating trafficking or abuse, but said the settlement would help close the matter. The deal still requires court approval. Plaintiffs' lawyers said settlement was the best option because many victims need financial relief now. The case is part of broader legal action against institutions accused of failing to act despite warning signs linked to Epstein.
