US gas prices hit \$4 per gallon, as Trump threatens to blow up Iran's energy facilities

U.S. gas prices have climbed to \$4 per gallon, reflecting growing pressure in global energy markets as tensions with Iran intensify. The increase comes amid concerns that any direct threat to Iran's energy infrastructure could disrupt oil supply routes and push prices even higher. Former President Donald Trump's warning has added to market anxiety, raising fears of broader instability in the region. Congressman writes to King Charles urging him to meet Epstein victims during US visit

Democratic Congressman Ro Khanna has urged King Charles to meet Jeffrey Epstein's victims during his expected visit to the United States, arguing that the case is not only an American issue but also has British dimensions because of Epstein's links to UK figures and institutions. Khanna said such a meeting would allow survivors to be heard directly and could help uncover any additional information held by British individuals or institutions. He also noted that Congress had sought testimony from Prince Andrew and Peter Mandelson over their ties to Epstein, but without success.



European nations criticise Israel's death penalty plans

France, Germany, Italy and the UK have expressed deep concern over an Israeli bill that would expand the use of the death penalty, warning it could disproportionately target Palestinians and undermine democratic principles. The proposal, backed by Israel's far-right government, is expected to go to further readings in the Knesset. Human rights groups, including Amnesty International, and UN experts have also criticized the bill, arguing it could turn the death penalty into a discriminatory tool against Palestinians while limiting judicial discretion and preventing courts from properly considering individual circumstances.
