The Extreme Positions Trump Proposes – and Republicans Embrace

This analysis argues that Donald Trump has repeatedly advanced ideas once seen as politically unthinkable, and that many Republican voters have increasingly accepted them. Citing several recent polls, the article says Republican support has extended to proposals involving attacks on Iranian civilian infrastructure, threats against Iran, military action in other countries, and even constitutionally or legally questionable ideas at home. It suggests this reflects less a debate over policy details than a broader pattern of political loyalty, through which Trump keeps pushing the boundaries of acceptable discourse and expands support for actions once considered extreme.



Iran Closes Strait of Hormuz Again ‘Until US Lifts Blockade’

Iran said it has reimposed restrictions on the Strait of Hormuz after the US refused to lift its blockade on Iranian ports. Tehran stated the waterway will remain under strict military control unless freedom of navigation for Iranian-linked shipping is restored. Reports said IRGC boats fired at tankers during the short reopening window on Saturday. The strait had briefly reopened after a ceasefire linked to wider regional negotiations. The renewed restrictions deepen concerns over global energy supplies, as roughly 20% of the world’s oil and liquefied natural gas passes through the route.



French Soldier Killed in Attack on UN Mission in Southern Lebanon

A French peacekeeper serving with UNIFIL was killed and three others were wounded in southern Lebanon during a mission to clear and reopen a road to an isolated UN post. UNIFIL and French officials said initial assessments suggest the attack was likely carried out by non-state actors, allegedly Hezbollah, though the group denied involvement. French President Emmanuel Macron condemned the attack and called for accountability, while Lebanese authorities opened an investigation. Separately, the Israeli military said it had killed members of a militant cell in southern Lebanon, despite a newly announced temporary ceasefire.
