Trump arrives in China ahead of crucial Xi meeting

US President Donald Trump arrived in Beijing to a ceremonial welcome, opening a high-stakes visit with major global implications for relations between the world's two largest economies. After his first night in China, Trump is set to meet President Xi Jinping for talks on sensitive issues, including technology, trade and Taiwan. The trip is also shaped by the US-Israeli war with Iran and the resulting energy crisis, with Trump expected to urge Xi to pressure Iran to reopen the Strait of Hormuz and pursue peace. He is accompanied by senior officials and business leaders, including Tim Cook and Elon Musk.

Gunshots heard in Philippine Senate, says Senate president

Gunshots were heard inside the Philippine Senate building on Wednesday, according to Senate President Alan Peter Cayetano, while Senator Ronald "Bato" Dela Rosa remained inside resisting arrest under an International Criminal Court warrant. No casualties were reported, and officials said it was unclear who fired the shots. Police entered the building and ordered reporters and personnel to leave, while Senate security locked the steel doors. Dela Rosa, a close ally of former President Rodrigo Duterte, is accused by ICC prosecutors of conspiring in alleged crimes against humanity linked to the anti-drug campaign. Interior Secretary Jonvic Remulla said senators were safe.

Venezuela's acting president defends country's territory and rejects Trump's 51st state remarks

Venezuela's acting President Delcy Rodríguez rejected President Donald Trump's suggestion that he was "seriously considering" making Venezuela the 51st US state, saying the country would defend its sovereignty and independence. Speaking at the International Court of Justice in The Hague, Rodríguez addressed the claim during hearings over Venezuela's territorial dispute with Guyana over the resource-rich Essequibo region. She said the dispute should be resolved through political negotiations, not a court ruling. Guyana argues the 1899 border decision is valid, while Venezuela cites a 1966 agreement. The court's final, legally binding ruling is expected to take months amid heightened regional tensions.
