WHO declares Ebola outbreak in DR Congo an international emergency

The World Health Organization declared the Ebola outbreak in eastern DR Congo a public health emergency of international concern, warning of possible wider spread despite not classifying it as a pandemic. Around 246 suspected cases and 80 deaths have been reported, mainly in Ituri province, with confirmed cases also detected in Kinshasa, Goma, and Uganda. The outbreak is caused by the Bundibugyo strain, which has no approved vaccine or treatment. WHO cited insecurity, population movement, urban hotspots, and informal healthcare as key risks, while advising stronger surveillance, isolation, tracing, and no travel or trade restrictions.

Guns on the television and in Iran's streets as Trump renews war threats

As tensions rise between Iran and the United States, state-sponsored nightly rallies in Tehran are mobilizing supporters with anti-American chants and patriotic messaging. Many participants express readiness to defend Iran's nuclear and missile programs, rejecting US demands and fearing renewed US-Israeli strikes. Authorities have intensified the war footing through public weapons kiosks, basic civilian gun demonstrations, and state television segments featuring presenters holding or firing rifles. Yet public opinion is not uniform. Away from the rallies, some Iranians quietly voice opposition to war, calling for peace, normalcy, and a better future, though hardline official messaging increasingly dominates the public atmosphere.

Russia hammers Ukraine in biggest prolonged drone attack since war began

Russia launched its largest two-day aerial attack on Ukraine since the war began, targeting Kyiv with more than 1,560 drones and 56 missiles, according to President Volodymyr Zelensky. At least 25 people were killed and dozens injured, with a residential building in Kyiv among the hardest-hit sites. Authorities said several residents may still be missing under the rubble. Kyiv's mayor described the assault as the largest-scale attack on the capital and declared a day of mourning. Strikes also hit Kharkiv, Odesa, Poltava, and Zaporizhzhia, damaging energy and railway infrastructure, while Ukraine said it is preparing a response.
