Nato chief welcomes US sending 5,000 troops to Poland

President Donald Trump announced that the US will send an additional 5,000 troops to Poland, shortly after the Pentagon cancelled a planned 4,000-troop deployment. Trump said the decision reflected Washington's relationship with Polish President Karol Nawrocki, though he did not clarify whether the troops are linked to the cancelled deployment or a separate operation. NATO Secretary General Mark Rutte welcomed the move while noting Europe's shift toward reduced reliance on US security will continue. The announcement comes as Washington reviews its European military presence and presses NATO allies to increase burden-sharing, amid tensions over Iran and US troop levels.

Angry crowd sets Ebola hospital tents on fire in DR Congo

An angry crowd attacked Rwampara General Hospital in Ituri, eastern DR Congo, after relatives of a suspected Ebola victim were prevented from taking his body for burial. Protesters threw stones, burned isolation tents, and injured a healthcare worker before police intervened. Authorities said safe burials are essential because bodies of Ebola victims remain highly infectious. The unrest reflects deep mistrust, poor public awareness, and beliefs that Ebola is fabricated by outsiders. The outbreak, caused by the rare Bundibugyo strain, has killed more than 130 people, with cases spreading to Uganda and South Kivu. WHO says no vaccine is currently available.

Ultimate image for Saudi Arabia's football poster boy: Ronaldo wins title

Cristiano Ronaldo finally won his first major domestic title with Al-Nassr, scoring twice in a 4-1 win over Damac to secure the Saudi Pro League ahead of rivals Al-Hilal. Signed in 2022 to elevate Saudi football globally, Ronaldo has scored 129 goals for the club, including 100 in the league, but had faced criticism for failing to deliver a championship. The title strengthens Al-Nassr's status and offers validation for Saudi Arabia's high-spending football strategy. Yet controversy over league favoritism, PIF ownership, and questions about the future of Saudi sports investment remain, making the victory symbolic but complex.
