All eyes on Downing Street - what does the PM say, and when?

Labour figures expect Keir Starmer to announce a plan to leave office amid mounting pressure from his party and cabinet ministers. The crisis follows months of declining authority and Andy Burnham's strong by-election victory, which convinced many Labour MPs he may be better placed to confront Reform UK. Starmer's choices are narrowing: remove dissenting ministers and try to survive, or set a timetable for an orderly exit. Labour is now considering whether to hold a full leadership contest or move quickly to choose a successor.

US and Iran take steps to reduce Lebanon conflict and Strait of Hormuz tensions, mediators say

The US and Iran made encouraging progress in Switzerland-based talks mediated by Qatar and Pakistan, despite earlier tensions caused by President Donald Trump's threats to resume bombing Iran and take control of the Strait of Hormuz. Iran's foreign minister said oil sanctions were waived, frozen assets were released, and a reconstruction and development plan was launched. Mediators said both sides agreed to establish a high-level committee, a communication line for the Strait of Hormuz, and a de-confliction cell to help end military operations in Lebanon.

Colombian right-wing candidate De La Espriella wins tight presidential race

Right-wing candidate Abelardo De La Espriella narrowly won Colombia's presidential runoff, according to an initial count, with 49.66% against leftist Senator Ivan Cepeda's 48.70%. Cepeda said he would wait for final verification and challenge results from some ballot boxes. De La Espriella, endorsed by Donald Trump, campaigned on cracking down on crime, ending talks with armed groups, lowering taxes, expanding oil and gas, and cutting the state. His narrow mandate, high public debt, and a divided Congress may limit reforms. The result reflects a broader regional shift toward right-wing governments.
