Iran says no new commitments on nuclear sites after Vance says inspectors to be invited back

Iran denied making new commitments on allowing IAEA inspectors back into nuclear sites after JD Vance said talks could begin soon. Following Switzerland negotiations mediated by Qatar and Pakistan, the US temporarily waived sanctions, allowing Iranian oil sales in dollars and easing banking, insurance and transport restrictions. Mediators said both sides agreed on a 60-day roadmap toward a final deal, a communication line to prevent incidents in the Strait of Hormuz, and a de-confliction cell to help end military operations in Lebanon.

Downed US pilot reported seeing Iranian drones swarm in 'jellyfish' formation

A US F-15 pilot rescued after being shot down over Iran reportedly told intelligence officials he saw multiple Iranian drones hovering and moving together in a "jellyfish" formation before ejecting. The account triggered debate inside US intelligence, as officials questioned whether it reflected a new Iranian drone capability, a test, or confusion after the pilot's concussion. The formation, described as possible "one-to-many meshed networking," could allow coordinated drone swarms. The report comes as Washington and Tehran pursue ceasefire-linked talks, with Iran's drone program under renewed scrutiny.

Russian strikes injure six in Ukraine as fuel crisis deepens into Siberia

Russian overnight strikes wounded six people across Ukraine's Zaporizhzhia, Sumy and Kharkiv regions, while Kyiv briefly issued an air raid alert. The attacks followed a Ukrainian strike on a Russian missile-electronics plant in Voronezh that local officials said killed five people. As both sides continue exchanging attacks, Russia's fuel crisis has expanded into Siberia, with Omsk limiting gasoline and diesel sales and Novosibirsk preparing similar measures. Ukrainian strikes on Russian energy and logistics infrastructure have disrupted supplies far from the front line, including regions more than 2,000 kilometres away.
