Trump cancels signing of landmark bipartisan bill aimed at lowering housing costs

Donald Trump cancelled a planned signing of a major bipartisan housing bill just hours before the ceremony, saying he would not approve it until Congress passes strict voter ID legislation. The bill aims to reduce housing costs and expand supply through more than 40 measures, including easing homebuilding rules and limiting institutional purchases of single-family homes. Lawmakers from both parties expressed surprise, while some Republicans still expect Trump to sign it. Unless vetoed or delayed by Congress, the bill could become law within ten days.

Extreme heat is melting national records across Europe, with more coming Thursday

Europe is facing an intense heatwave that is breaking national records and placing major pressure on public services. France recorded its hottest day since records began, while the UK and Spain set new June temperature records. The UK issued rare red extreme heat warnings, with temperatures forecast to reach 39°C. In France, at least 40 people drowned while seeking relief from the heat. The extreme conditions are also straining electricity grids, leaving thousands without power in northwestern France and causing outages in parts of Italy, including Florence and Pescara, where a coastal swimming ban was imposed.

Israel says IDF is staying in southern Lebanon, undermining Iran peace talks

Israel's defence minister Israel Katz said Israeli troops will remain in southern Lebanon, complicating US-Iran peace talks that link a permanent deal to ending the Lebanon conflict. Iran insists Israel must stop operations and withdraw, while Israel says there is no US demand for withdrawal and prefers a phased handover to the Lebanese army. Despite a US-mediated Israel-Hezbollah ceasefire, Israeli strikes continued, killing two near Nabatieh. Meanwhile, US Secretary of State Marco Rubio toured Gulf states to reassure allies concerned that sanctions relief and possible funds for Iran could strengthen Tehran.
